

Hello Y State attendees!

We have some new updates from the meet host, so FYI below and good luck this weekend!

\*Parking for families should be in the field behind the pool. Only officials and coaches should park in the water park area.

\*Reminder per the meet information that spectators will not be allowed on pool deck, but each team can appoint to volunteers each afternoon session to help them get kids behind the blocks. (Our YCF coaches will determine these individuals and get them deck passes during warm up).

\*Saturday and Sunday morning warm-up times have been pushed up to **7:00am for YCF, (no longer 6:30am)**. Please plan to have your swimmers meet the YCF coaches on pool deck 10 minutes prior to the start of each warm up session for directions.

\* A meet committee will be meeting on Saturday morning to discuss moving the finals back an hour to 5:00pm, (to avoid the colder evening temps)... our coaches will update swimmers on the pool deck Saturday and Sunday morning as they know more, but FYI on this possibility.

\* Families can set up in the picnic area and zero water park areas. The actual water park will be closed to families.

Also – although the original meet information required each team to provide volunteer timers for every session, they are currently only asking for people interested in volunteer timing to come to the admin box prior to the session.
